Seminar on Pipe Cable Locator

The Technical seminar was jointly organized by Hong Kong Institute of Utility Specialists (HKIUS) and Construction Professionals' Development Centre (CPDC), funded by the Commerce and Economic Development Bureau of the HKSAR, supported by Hong Kong College of Technology (Causeway Bay Campus) (HKCT) was held successfully on 26 February in Hong Kong Polytechnic University (Rm. N002) which 117 participants attended the seminar.

With the completion of the guidebooks and pamphlets on the 12 disciplines, a series of technical seminar was being held to disseminate the research result.

The second topic was Utility Survey using Pipe Cable Locator. Dr. Rebecca Tse Oi Chi from LSGI of the HK Polytechnic University was the speaker of the topic. As pipe cable locator becomes more and more common in detection of underground utilities, Dr. Tse described the equipment, application and procedures of conducting utility survey. She emphasized on the importance of employing qualified personnel to undergo the survey. The Electronic Marking System, a rather new technology in utility surveying was also introduced.

The seminar ended by an interactive question-and-answer session. It gave them insights towards the topic. We specially thanked the speakers for sharing his valuable experience.
